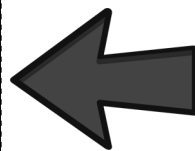

- Goodbye! Koe kia!



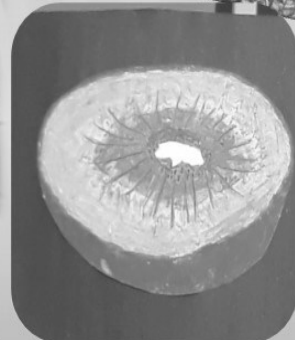
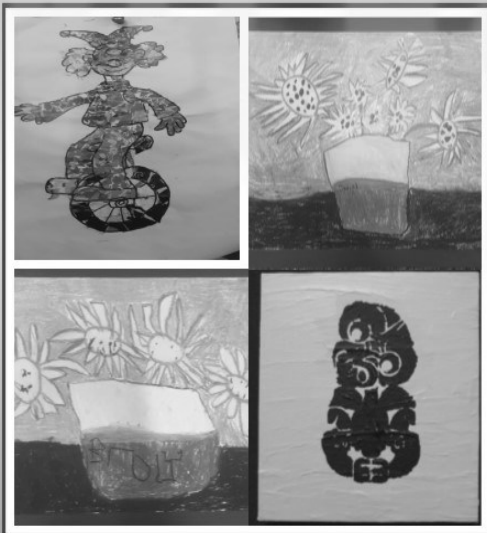
