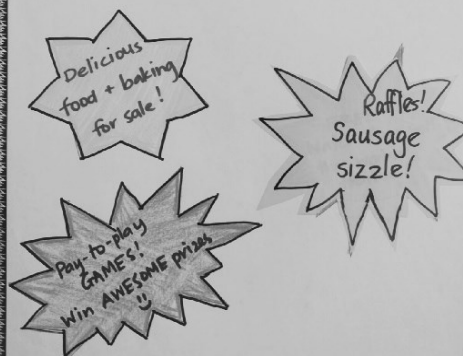

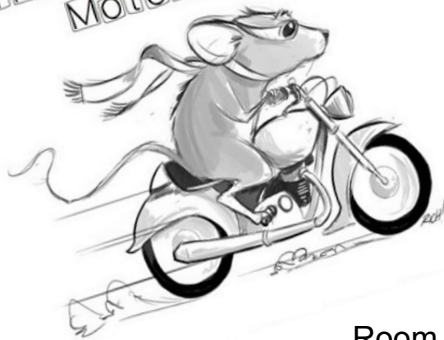
BUY & TRADE TABLE
