Thank you for your positive response to the changes we recently introduced to our Individual Grants programme. Your feedback has been very encouraging as we continue to look for ways to improve how we work with you and the families we serve.

Today, we are happy to share with you the changes we have made to the Kiwi Kid Sponsorship (KKS) programme – we have made it even more flexible and responsive to the needs of children and their whānau.

In addition to the improvements we've made, we have moved all KKS applications online to allow us to speed up processing times. Any new applications should be submitted online from 1 August 2020.

Following are the changes to the programme:

KKS Criteria	KKS Before	KKS Now
Maximum no. of children per family	4 children	No maximum. All the children in your care.
Age of eligibility when applying	4.5 years old – 15 years old	4 years old – 17 years old (4th birthday until 17th birthday)
KKS funds to buy a laptop	Not allowed	Can use up to \$200 towards the purchase of a digital device
Income limits	Based on how many children you have.	Now based on household income similar to WINZ:  Family of: Weekly income: 2 \$900 3 \$1,005 4 \$1,135 5 \$1,260 6 \$1,395 7 \$1,520 8 \$1,645
