School Donations

This year the Coalition Government have introduced a Government School Donations' scheme for 2020.

Currently, parents at Edmonton School are asked to pay a school donation of \$50 at the beginning of each year. However, because it is a donation, not a fee, parents do not have to pay it. Traditionally, only about 1/3 of our parents have paid this donation each year.

The new offer:

The government have offered all Decile 1 to Decile 7 schools the option of the government paying \$150 donation for each student. Our Board of Trustees has opted into this scheme, therefore from 2020 Edmonton School parents will not have to pay a school donation.

What the donation will cover:

Under the Government School Donation Scheme schools are expected to use the donations to pay for:

- Curriculum resources
- School trips, performances by outside groups which are linked to the curriculum

What the donation does not cover:

The Government School Donation Scheme will not cover:

- School camp
- Extra curricula activities (e.g. after school sports)
- Goods and services (e.g. stationery, uniforms, lunch orders)

Please note that we will still need to fundraise for school projects.
