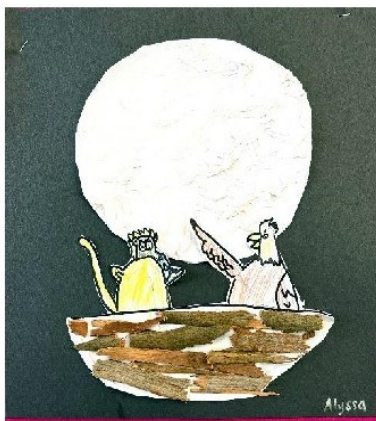
I like the eagle. I used to live in the nest but baboon is in there. So I went to live in the nest. So we had a fight until we were both tired. Then we decided to share my nest.
