Rm 9 – MATHEMATICS Measurement - VOLUME

Senior students of room 9 working outside and learning about Volume. They are creating 1m by 1m by 1m cubes using rulers. They are understanding the concept of measuring the space an object takes up.

They are learning to:

- Use and read units of Measurement – mm, cm and m.
- Use measuring devices to measure correctly
- Understand what Area and Volume are
- Use the formula $V = L \times W \times H$ to calculate Volume
