The first thing our group did was going to an old school. Srivasthina



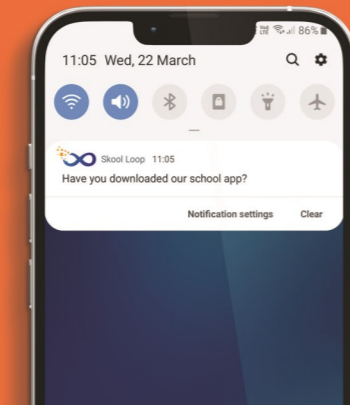
I went inside this massive building with very old cars and huge engine. Carys
