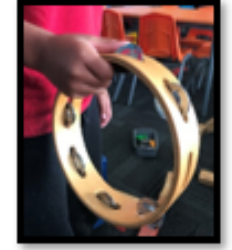
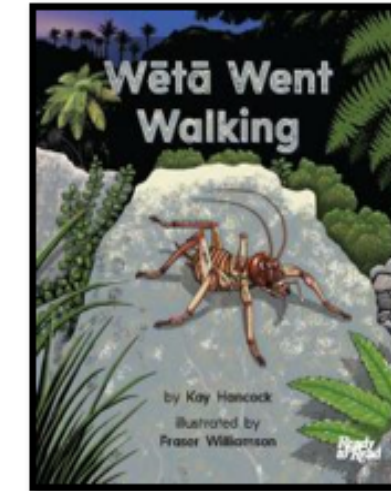

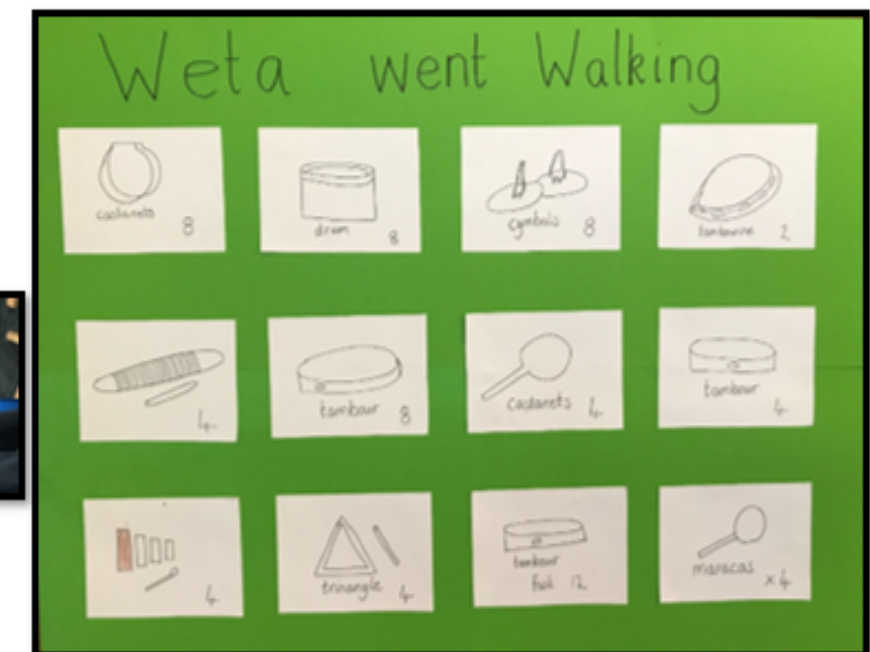
Room 4 have been reading the story
