All the best for our Junior school who are going to Crystal Mountain for their school trip. You are all very excited and I know you will have a great time.

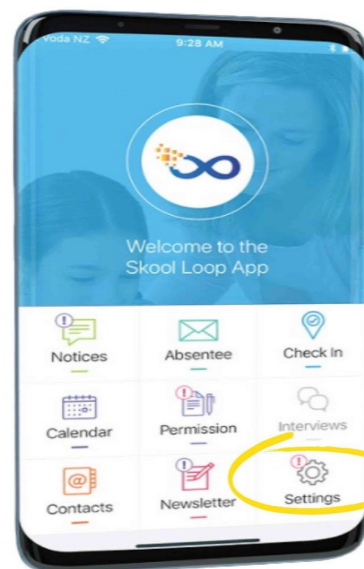

ROOM 11 NEWS FOR TERM 2

During this term we have had done quite a bit of learning and had a few fun experiences. At the start of the term, we had a visit by Russell French talking to and showing us different musical instruments. We even got to play some.



We also learnt about the ANZACs and the importance of the New Zealand's contribution. As part of this learning, we got to bake some ANZAC biscuits. This helped us with our fractions learning as well. Then we also did some art around the ANZACs and worked on some Silhouette Art using water paints and oil pastels. We also had some digital technology sessions working with James Robson around our topic of music using Makey Makey: An Invention Kit for Everyone, a kit designed to connect everyday objects to computer keys. Using a circuit board, alligator clips, and a USB cable, the "toy" uses closed loop electrical signals to send the computer either a keyboard stroke or mouse click signal to make music or play the piano.



In math we have been learning about algebra-equality integrated with number. We have also been learning about multiplication and division, learning various strategies to solve multiplication equations. Then we moved onto fractions where we learnt that a fraction is a part of a whole; what a proper, improper and mixed number fractions are. We looked at finding various fractions of a whole and a set.
