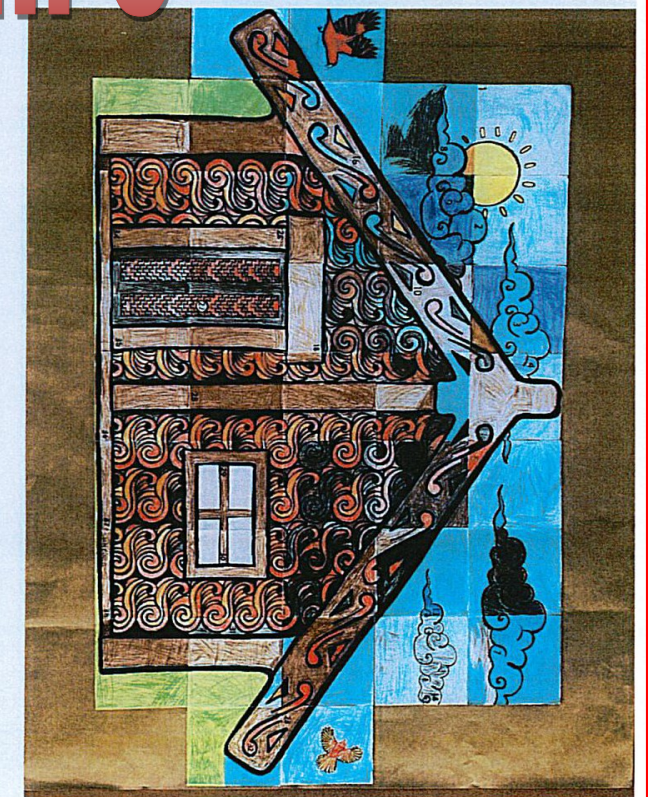
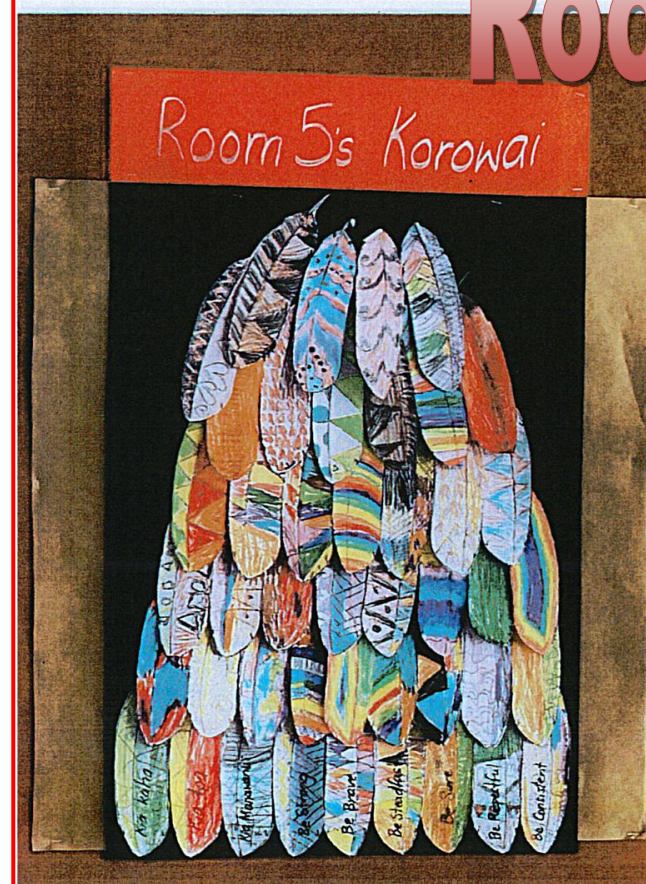
The Weekend
