He discovered that there wasn't a big southern continent!


Captain Cook and his crew were tasked with proving or disproving the existence of Terra Australis, a large southern landmass that some scientists believed existed.

The goat travelled all the way around the world with Captain Cook's crew, which was believed to be the first time an animal had done that.




Edmonton Primary School Reporting to Parents




