

Cats are one of the most beloved animals in the world. They are graceful, agile and playful, and they make wonderful companions. Cats can jump up to 6 times their height.

That's right!

Cats are really good jumpers and can jump really high.

You can often see them on the top of a garden fence or on a really high wall! They have very strong muscles in their legs which catapults them into the air

They have a total of 18 toes.

That's a lot of toes!

Cats have 5 toes on each of their front paws.

They then have four toes on their back paws.

There are over 500 million pet cats!

There are lots of cats across the world as they are one of the most popular pets to have.


